
New volume released at Amazon

A long time researcher and Artist Arto Heino, has just released a compilation of Essays, Studies and his Artwork, it covers his writings from the Arts and Sciences. He has been active in researches since the early 90's and looks in areas where most never explore, such as the hidden designs behind seemingly simple circuits. He has sections on Nikola Tesla , Lester Hendershot and Don Smith. Not just a copy and paste of what other have said but new insights into some of these inventors ideas.

Arto has a chapter on Astro-archeology and decided to even create a new category, Archeogeometry, where new ideas about the past can be addressed. He shows this by reexamining the Ancient Giza Pyramid and shows a new way of understanding its numeric code.

As he quotes from his blog, "Regarding my unique approach of utilising Quantum Arithmetic, it is only a natural arithmetic system of whole numbers that are just solutions looking for a problem. Abandoning the decimal system, Calculus and computers would be asking too much of a sacrifice to modern scientists and engineers, but this is what is required to come to a level of understanding that the ancient builders had used. As an artist I do not have these prejudices, I am free to explore and arrive at solutions that teams of dedicated professionals would never bother to look at as it does not follow their learned

practices."

In another chapter, he also draws some cartoon characters from our desperate economic conditions and the global overlords. Every chapter heading has one of his unique masterpieces for you to enjoy, as he gives you an interesting journey through some of his essays and the studies of ideas, machinery, circuits and our human condition. He has designs that are both easy to understand and has many complex layers hiding in each special schematic he draws. A treasure trove of ideas to draw from, covering many years of work, great for the inventors and researches into alternate energy systems.

The book is chock full of some of his writing dating back to the late 90's, it has 12 Chapters, 356 pages over 250 illustrations and over 70 charts. Taken from an Artists perspective on the world he studies. A book where Art, Engineering and the ancient world meet. Highly illustrated , with artwork, numeric tables, geometries, designs and schematics. This is Volume I, Volume II is being complied at present.

Arto Juhani Heino, is a Finish born Australian resident, and has been active in the arts since the early 1970's, and was a portrait Artist in the 1980's, and is currently a well known chalk artist in Sydney. Along side his paint brush and pencil have been his soldering iron and his interests in astronomy. He has written three previous publications in 1996 and 1997 refer his Nexus review in 1998 and this volume is the continuation of his work. He is self taught in all of the mathematics and geometry as there are no teachers for the many new ideas that have not been explored by others.
